The Arizona Department of Administration's Enterprise Procurement Services Division (EPS) has awarded WI-VOD a service contract in response to a state solicitation for Telecommunication Carrier Services. With our focus to deliver broadband to communities severely underserved even in today's E-commerce world, our work with the State of Arizona over the next three years will enable many local, county and state agencies and organizations to enhance services to their constituents." As outlined by EPS, these contracts were awarded to meet the telecommunication carrier needs of the state telecommunications program (*AZNet*), the political subdivisions, municipalities and special districts that make up the State Purchasing Cooperative. The awards followed strict federal procurement requirements and coordination with the Government Information Technology Agency and the Department of Education, making it easier for schools and libraries to obtain federal "e-rate" funding to help pay for Internet access and programs for Arizona's children. Along with WI-VOD, contracts were awarded to: AT & T, Cox Arizona Telecom, Mountain Telecommunications, Qwest Communications, Strategic Technology Communications, and Telespectra.
